**New Town World Heritage Site and Communal Bin Hubs**

We refer to your email to Jenifer Stirton of 6<sup>th</sup> August 2021 (Case AR324) and note that you propose writing to all residents to ascertain their views on the City of Edinburgh Council's proposals to introduce communal bin hubs throughout Edinburgh and, in particular, to replace the existing scheme of gull-proof bags and red and blue recycling boxes used in the historic New Town.

We are unsure whether you intended to write to all of your constituents on this matter or only those based within New Town and Broughton Community Council's catchment area.

Please note that we, Stockbridge and Inverleith Community Council [SICC], and many of our Residents' Associations, are also greatly concerned about these proposals and the effect upon our historic streets.

We would, therefore, seek an assurance from you that you shall also be writing to all of your constituents within SICC's catchment area affected by these proposals seeking their views and that you shall then put those views to the Transport and Environment Committee of the City of Edinburgh Council for its consideration.
